ATTENTION HAZMAT DRIVERS

The Hazardous Materials Endorsement Threat Assessment Program conducts a threat assessment for any driver seeking to obtain, renew and transfer a hazardous materials endorsement on a state-issued Commercial Driver's License. The assessment includes collecting the individual's fingerprints and verification of US citizenship, immigration eligibility or permanent legal residence in the United States.

- Complete the online application, schedule an appointment, and find an application center on the TSA HazMat website (<u>www.tsa.gov/for-industry/hazmat-endorsement</u>). For assistance call the toll-free Driver Help Desk at (855) 347-8371 weekdays, 8am to 10pm.
- You will need a valid U.S. passport <u>or</u> a driver's license and birth certificate. See the website above for other acceptable documents.
- A non-refundable fee of \$85.25 can be paid by credit card, money order, company check or certified/cashier's check (no cash will be accepted). If paying by money order or check, do not fill out.

Important Notice: TSA recommends that all applicants enroll for the HME Security Threat Assessment (including renewals) a minimum of 60 days before applicants require an eligibility determination. TSA is experiencing increased demand for HME assessments, and the processing times for some applicants may exceed 45 days.
